GOING THE DISTANCE TO SUPPORT EVEN MORE HOSPITALIZED CHILDREN AND THEIR FAMILIES

AbbVie Donates \$2.4 Million to Ronald McDonald House Charities Oklahoma City for Expansion at The Children's Hospital at OU Medicine

OKLAHOMA CITY (November 9, 2018) – AbbVie, a research-based global biopharmaceutical company, has stepped up to support Ronald McDonald House Charities Oklahoma City's expansion at The Children's Hospital at OU Medicine with a \$2.4 million donation to provide housing and family-centered services for pediatric patients and their families.

"Having a child with a serious illness is one of the most difficult experiences anyone can face," said Laura Schumacher, executive vice president, external affairs, general counsel and corporate secretary, AbbVie. "Our donation is grounded in the shared belief that families should have the necessary resources to care for a hospitalized child, along with the support to strengthen their well-being and resiliency during a challenging time."

Recognizing the unique needs of families with a hospitalized child, AbbVie's support will further enable RMHC-OKC to provide a welcoming place for families to stay, along with the critical services they need. The donation will be used to build family-centered spaces at The Ronald McDonald House at The Children's Hospital. The third floor of Garrison Tower, where the Ronald McDonald House resides, currently supports 14 families a night. After the expansion is completed on the fourth floor of Garrison Tower, RMHC-OKC will be able to serve 40 families while saving guest families over \$1 million a year in food and lodging costs.

"The number of nightly stays by families needing our services has increased by 57% in just the last three years," said Susan Adams, RMHC-OKC president and CEO. This extraordinary gift from AbbVie will keep us from having to turn away hundreds of families seeking comfort, support and hope each year."

RMHC-OKC helps families from all across Oklahoma be able to choose the best care for their child without worry to the financial burden that travel and hotels may bring. In 2017 RMHC-OKC served nearly 900 families for nearly 9,000 nights from 73 of the 77 Oklahoma Counties.

Once the new addition to the Ronald McDonald House is completed in 2020, RMHC-OKC will be able to allow for nearly 9,500 additional night stays for pediatric patients and their families each year at The Children's Hospital.

"Adding more rooms to the Ronald McDonald House at The Children's Hospital comes at a time when more patients and their families are coming to our hospital than ever before, specifically for advanced surgeries like those performed by our Children's surgical specialists," said Cameron Mantor, M.D., chief medical officer for The Children's Hospital and chief of pediatric surgery. "Our team is here when Oklahomans need us most, whether it's for surgical, neonatal, oncologic or specialized medical care, and having a Ronald McDonald House just steps away helps keep our families close when their children need them most."

RMHC-OKC is one of 32 RMHC chapters nationwide to be gifted a portion of AbbVie's \$100 million donation to RMHC. Chapters were chosen by current state of expansion project and community support for expansion costs.
